

# Businesses join in Arizona Science Center environmental day

Businesses will get in the act Saturday as the **Arizona Science Center** hosts its second annual Global Awareness Day to spotlight environmental responsibility.

Sponsored by c.i. Development Group, the event will run from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and feature about 20 local companies providing discussions and activities for adults and children.

"Learning to be environmentally responsible is top of mind for many people, especially in the dry Arizona desert," said Kristin Priscella, director of marketing and public relations at Arizona Science Center, said in a release. "It is amazing to learn about the impact that we as individuals can have, just by making a few simple changes to our daily routines."

Admission is \$9 for adults and \$7 for children and seniors. Admission to the downtown Phoenix facility's current featured exhibition, "CSI: Crime Scene Insects," will cost an additional \$2 for adults and \$1 for children and seniors.
